

At the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Florida, we are proud of our award-winning website. We want to keep our website current, accurate, helpful, and accessible. To reach our goals, we made some changes to the website.

On September 29, 2017, several new features went live on the website.

We created a new one-stop shop for most resources that the public uses named “The Source.” The Source appears in the lower left box at the center of the homepage. In The Source, you will find links to the Bankruptcy Code and Rules, our Local Rules and Administrative Orders, judicial opinions, CLE materials, a case digest, the Negative Notice and Accompanying Orders Lists, the Court’s calendar, and the Procedure Manual.

We updated every procedure in our Procedure Manual, and we created new procedures that will further help our users. We moved all forms that appeared on the homepage of the website to the Procedure Manual.

We listened to your suggestions and improved the Procedure Manual further by adding these new enhancements: (1) the Procedure Manual is now entirely searchable, for example, users can search by keyword or code section, (2) the procedures themselves reference the applicable chapters of the Bankruptcy Code, (3) the Procedure Manual is now downloadable and printable, and (4) every procedure has a last-updated line that will appear in the procedure itself and next to the procedure on the table of contents.
