ORDER ALLOWING COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT
OF EXPENSES ON AMENDED APPLICATION FOR FEES FOR
ATTORNEYS FOR DEBTOR

THIS CASE came on for hearing on September 25, 2013, on the Application for Attorney's Fees for Attorneys for Debtor filed by R. John Cole, II, Esquire, of R. John Cole, II & Associates, P.A., attorneys for the Debtor (Doc. No. 68). For the reasons stated orally and recorded in open court that shall constitute the decision of the Court, the application for fees and expenses are approved in the amounts requested. It is thereupon,

ORDERED:

1. That R. John Cole, II, & Associates, P.A., attorneys for the Debtor, is granted total fees in the amount of \$16,198.00, and total expenses in the amount of \$1,965.67; for a total allowance of fees and expenses of \$18,163.67 less the \$10,713.00 retainer paid.

2. Therefore, R. John Cole, II, & Associates, P.A. is granted a total administrative expense in the amount of \$7,450.67, which is authorized to be and shall be paid by the Debtor at this time.
