ORDER AUTHORIZING EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEY

Based upon the facts set forth in the foregoing application to employ attorney and declaration, Document Number 23, the Court concludes that the attorney does not hold or represent an interest adverse to the estate and is a disinterested person within the meaning of Section 101(14) of the Bankruptcy Code. The court further concludes that the attorney is qualified to represent the trustee and that the Court's authorization of the attorney's employment is in the best interest of the estate.
