**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

This matter came before the Court on the Trustee's Motion Directed to Reca Rene Chamberlain Seeking to Compel Production of Documents and Compliance with Court Orders in Regard to Document Production (Doc. No. 768) ("Motion to Compel") filed by Soneet R. Kapila, the Chapter 11 Trustee ("Trustee") for the bankruptcy estate of Louis J. Pearlman ("Pearlman"), seeking the turnover of documents and information from Reca René Chamberlain and her law firm (collectively, "Chamberlain").

Chamberlain submitted to the Court an email transmission dated November 8, 2006 from Michael Gay with Foley & Lardner LLP to lawdoctor@email.com for *in camera* review, but failed to submit the attachments referenced in the email and her privilege log. An Order was entered on February 5, 2008 (Doc. No. 1069) directing Chamberlain to:

submit to the Court, within seven (7) days from the date of entry of this Order, the attachments to the November 8, 2006 email transmission described as "copy of email and documents attached" for *in camera* review to determine whether such documents are protected by the attorney-client or work product privileges.

No reconsideration or appeal of the February 5, 2008 Order was sought.

Chamberlain has failed to comply with the February 5, 2008 Order.

Accordingly, it is

**ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that Reca René Chamberlain, individually and as a principal of her law firm, is hereby directed to appear on April 10, 2008 at 10:00 a.m. in Courtroom A, Fifth Floor, 135 West Central Boulevard, Orlando, Florida, to show cause why she and her firm should not be held in contempt of Court for their failure to comply with the February 5, 2008 Order and why sanctions should not be imposed against her and her firm pursuant to 11 U.S.C. Section 105(a) and the Court's inherent powers.
