ORDER

This matter came before the Court on the Paramount Creditor's Expressed Notice of Objection to the Granting of Wachovia Bank, N.A.'s Motion for Relief from Automatic Stay (Doc. No. 59) ("Objection") filed by Kenneth Scott Vitale, the Debtor herein, and who refers to himself as the "Paramount Creditor." An evidentiary hearing was held on May 28, 2008 on Wachovia's stay relief motion regarding real property located at 3840 Biscayne Drive, Winter Springs, Florida 32708 at which counsel for Wachovia and Rod Fischer, as a representative of the Debtor (*see* Doc. No. 50), appeared. Fischer stated the Debtor's objections to stay relief were set forth in the Debtor's papers and rested on the papers.

The Debtor established no basis for denial of Wachovia's stay relief motion and an Order was entered on June 6, 2008 (Doc. No. 57) granting Wachovia relief from the automatic stay. The Debtor apparently seeks reconsideration of that Order through his Objection. He has established no basis for reconsideration or amendment of the June 6, 2008 Order.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Objection (Doc. No. 59) is hereby **OVERRULED** and all relief sought in the Objection is hereby **DENIED**.
