**ORDER**

This matter came before the Court on the Motion to Reopen Bankruptcy Case (Doc. No. 86) and Objection to Trustee's Final Report (Doc. No. 87) filed by Leshawn Roundtree, the *pro se* Debtor herein ("Debtor").

An Order was entered on December 18, 2008 (Doc. No. 76) dismissing this case due to the Debtor's failure to make plan payments. The effective date of the Order was delayed fourteen days to permit the Debtor to convert the case. The Debtor did not file a notice of conversion. The Debtor did not timely appeal the December 18, 2008 Order and his appeal was dismissed.

The December 18, 2008 Order is a final, non-appealable order. The Debtor has not established any basis for reopening this case and his Motion to Reopen is due to be denied.

The Chapter 13 Trustee filed her Final Report and Account on February 3, 2009 (Doc. No. 82), which sets forth the Trustee received no plan payments from the Debtor. The Debtor objects to the Final Report on the basis he contests various claims. Any claim objections are moot due to the closing of this case and the Debtor's Objection to Trustee's Final Report is due to be overruled.

Accordingly, it is

**ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED** that the Debtor's Motion to Reopen Bankruptcy Case (Doc. No. 86) is hereby **DENIED**; and it is further

**ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED** that the Debtor's Objection to Trustee's Final Report (Doc. No. 87) is hereby **OVERRULED**.
