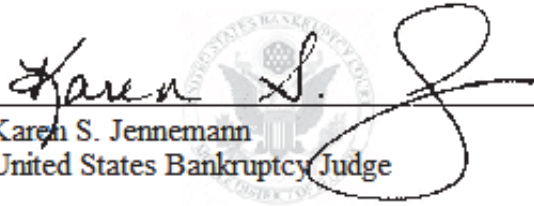

**ORDER DENYING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR SANCTIONS**  
**AND DISMISSING ADVERSARY PROCEEDING WITH PREJUDICE**

Pursuant to the Memorandum Opinion Denying Plaintiffs' Motion for Sanctions and Dismissing Adversary Proceeding with Prejudice, entered simultaneously, it is:

ORDERED:

1. Plaintiffs' Motion for Sanctions (Doc. No. 26) is denied.
2. Defendants' Motion to Dismiss (Doc. No. 48) is granted.
3. Plaintiffs lack standing to assert the claims raised in this adversary proceeding.
4. All other pending motions are denied as moot, including: Ally Servicing, LLC's Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings (Doc. No. 32); Ally Servicing LLC's Motion for Protective Order (Doc. No. 59); Ally Servicing, LLC's Request for Expedited Hearing (Doc. No. 63), and Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment (Doc. No. 67).
5. This adversary proceeding is dismissed with prejudice.
