**FINAL JUDGMENT REVOKING DISCHARGE AND FOR MONEY DUE AND OWING**



ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Discharge of Debtor granted on January 26, 2005 is hereby revoked. It is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that there is due and owing to the Plaintiff, ROBERT E. TARDIF JR., Trustee, from the Defendant, CINDY MYERS, the sum of \$4,201.30, costs in the amount of \$150.00 for a total judgment amount of \$4,351.30, in addition to 10/12ths of any 2004 federal income tax refund. The total judgment amount shall accrue interest pursuant to law, for all of which let execution issue.
