**ORDER GRANTING DEBTOR'S MOTION TO DETERMINE SECURED STATUS OF  
REAL TIME RESOLUTIONS, INC. AGENT FOR JPMORGAN CHASE BANK, N.A.  
AND TO STRIP LIEN EFFECTIVE UPON DISCHARGE**

**THIS CASE** is before the Court on the Debtor's Motion to Determine Secured Status of Real Time Resolutions, Inc., agent for JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A. and to Strip Lien (Docket No. 70) (the "Motion"), which was served on all interested parties on January 10, 2014 with Local Rule 2002-4 negative notice legend informing the parties of their opportunity to object within 30 days of the date of service. No party filed an objection within the time permitted. The Court therefore considers the matter to be unopposed. It is

**ORDERED:**

1. The Motion is **GRANTED**.
2. Claim No. 17 (Class 2) by Real Time Resolutions, Inc., agent for JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A. shall be treated as an unsecured claim in the Chapter 11 Case.
3. The real property (the "Real Property") that is subject of the Motion is located at 3371 Ivy Bridge Court, Jacksonville, Florida 32226.
4. The mortgage held by Real Time Resolutions, Inc., agent for JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A. recorded on July 11, 2005, at Book 12602, Page 1095, Document No. 2005250538, of the official records of Duval County, Florida, shall be deemed void and shall be

extinguished automatically, without further court order, upon entry of the Debtor's discharge in this Chapter 11 case; provided, however, that the Court reserves jurisdiction to consider, if appropriate, the avoidance of Real Time Resolutions, Inc., agent for JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A.'s lien prior to the entry of the Debtor's discharge. Further, if this case is converted to a case under Chapter 7, or if this Chapter 11 case is dismissed, the mortgage will no longer be considered void and shall be restored as a secured debt.
