PARTIAL SUMMARY FINAL JUDGMENT
(As to Count IV of the Complaint)

THIS MATTER came on for consideration upon the Court's own motion for the purpose of entering an appropriate order in the above-captioned adversary proceeding. The Court reviewed the record and finds that an Order has been entered granting summary judgment in favor of Plaintiffs, Synectic Ventures I, LLC, Synectic Ventures, II, LLC, and Synectic Ventures III, LLC and against Defendant, Craig Berkman, with respect to Count IV of the Complaint. 
ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. Summary judgment is hereby granted in favor of Synectic Ventures I, LLC, Synectic Ventures, II, LLC, and Synectic Ventures III, LLC and against the Debtor, Craig Berkman.
2. The debt owed by Craig Berkman to Synectic Ventures I, LLC, Synectic Ventures, II, LLC, and Synectic Ventures, III, LLC in the principal amount of \$10,000,000.00, plus 9% interest per annum on the principal amount of judgment from the date judgment is entered until paid, as set forth in the Limited Judgment (With Money Award) For Synectic Ventures I, LLC, Synectic Ventures II, LLC, and Synectic Ventures III, LLC Against Craig L. Bermand, Synectic Asset Management, Inc., Synectic Ventures Management I, Inc, Synectic Ventures Management II, Inc., and Synectic Ventures Management III, Inc. For Punitive Damages, recorded in the Public Records for Hillsborough County, Florida at Book 18981, Pages 1017-1027, is hereby determined to be non-dischargeable pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 523(a)(6).
