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**FINAL JUDGMENT**

THIS MATTER came on upon the Chapter 7 Trustee (Susan K. Woodard, whose mailing address is P.O. Box 7828, Saint Petersburg, Florida 33734) affidavit of default on the respective orders on the Amended Motions for Turnover, Damages, Sanctions and Other Relief for Failure to List IBM Stock, 179 Kohler Street, 770 Wellington Street, Treasury Bonds (Document Numbers 601, 603, 604, and 607, respectively) in the general bankruptcy proceedings. The Court ordered the Debtor to turnover certain property and proceeds as a result of said Motions, within a date certain, and the Debtor failed to comply. For the reasons stated orally and in the aforesaid Motion and Orders on the same (the Orders on each of the Motions are docketed at 694, 695, 696, and 697) that failure to comply would warrant a final judgment that may be record to allow execution or garnishment as the case may be. Accordingly, it is,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Chapter 7 Trustee of the Estate herein shall be entitled to a Final Judgment as follows:

1. \$4,501.60 plus interest as prescribed by 28 U.S.C. Section 1961;
2. \$6,570.61 plus interest as prescribed by 28 U.S.C. Section 1961;

This Final Judgment shall act as an assignment of the Debtor's interest in the realty located 179 Kohler St., Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario (more particularly described as Lot No. 23, Stafford Subdivision, Plan 9288, in the City of Sault Ste. Marie, in the District of Algoma), and

3. This Final Judgment shall act as an assignment of the Debtor's interest in the realty located 770 Wellington St., Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario (more particularly described as Plan 2020 Lot 57 PT Lot 56 PT Lot 58 RP 1R5417 Part 2, Property Roll No. 020-036-027-00-0000-00).

4. The Court shall reserve jurisdiction to enter orders that may be necessary to

comply with foreign law consistent with the foregoing.


