
JUDGMENT

This proceeding and adversary proceeding No. 3:06-ap-0080-JAF came before the court on Plaintiff's Motions to Enforce Settlement and for Entry of Judgment of Nondischargeability. Upon the Order Granting Plaintiff's Motion to Enforce Settlement dated July 18, 2007, separately entered in the adversary proceeding styled *KeyBank, N.A. v. Robert Adamo*; Adv. Pro. No.: 3:06-ap-0080-JAF (Adv. Doc. 55), it is **ADJUDGED**:

1. Judgment in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 is entered in favor of Plaintiff, KeyBank, N.A. ("Plaintiff"), whose business address is 127 Public Square, 5th Floor, Cleveland, Ohio, 44109, and against Defendants, Robert Adamo, whose last known address is 126 Alexandra Woods Drive, Debary, Florida 32713, and Anton Patch, whose last known address is 214 Lamonte Point Court, Debary, Florida 32713, (collectively, the "Defendants"), jointly and severally, which shall accrue post-judgment interest from the date of the judgment at 4.91 % per annum, for all of which let execution issue.

2. This \$2,000,000.00 and post-judgment interest accrued thereon which is owed by the Defendants to Plaintiff is excepted from the Defendants' discharges and is nondischargeable pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 523(a)(2)(A).
