IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:


1. A Final Judgment be, and the same is hereby, entered on the Complaint in favor of American Express Centurion Bank, the Plaintiff, and against Gregory S. Norton and Sheila D. Sheila Norton, the Defendants, in the amount of \$7,230.25, and the debt owed by the Defendants to the Plaintiff in the amount of \$7,230.25 is hereby declared to be non-dischargeable pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §523(a)(14A).

2. That pursuant to the Joint Stipulation to Judgment, the Defendants shall make payment to Plaintiff in the amount of \$7,230.25, to be paid in accordance with the terms set forth in the Joint Stipulation to Judgment.

3. The Plaintiff shall not place the Judgment in the Public Records and shall not take any steps to collect the debt declared to be non-dischargeable by obtaining a Writ of Execution or a Writ of Replevin or levy on any properties of the Defendants as long as the Defendants complies with the repayment terms set forth in the Joint Stipulation to Judgment.

4. That in the event the Defendants default on the repayment terms as specified in paragraph six (6) of the Joint Stipulation to Judgment, the Plaintiff is authorized to proceed to enforce the Judgment pursuant to the provisions of the applicable law.
