FINAL JUDGMENT

THIS CASE came before the Court for the purpose of entering a Final Judgment in this adversary proceeding. For the reasons stated on the record in open Court on December 11, 2007, which shall constitute the decision of the Court, it is appropriate to enter a Final Judgment on the Trustee's Complaint for Turnover of Property to the Estate and Objection to Discharge.

Accordingly:

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. As to Count I of the Complaint, for Turnover under 11 U.S.C. §542, Final Judgment is entered in favor of the Plaintiff, V. John Brook, Jr., as Chapter 7 Trustee, and against the Debtor, Glenda Ruth

Storm, to the extent of the Debtor's 2006 income tax refund, and the Debtor is directed to turn over the sum of \$2,529.00 to the Chapter 7 Trustee.


2. As to the balance of the relief requested in Count I of the Complaint, Final Judgment is entered in favor of the Debtor, Glenda Ruth Storm, and against the Plaintiff, V. John Brook, Jr., as Chapter 7 Trustee.

3. As to Count II of the Complaint, for Denial of Discharge under 11 U.S.C. §727(a)(4), Final Judgment is entered in favor of the Debtor, Glenda Ruth Storm, and against the Plaintiff, V. John Brook, Jr., as Chapter 7 Trustee

4. A Discharge of Debtor shall be entered in the Chapter 7 case of the Debtor, Glenda Ruth Storm.
