

**ORDER GRANTING DEBTORS' MOTION
TO VALUE CLAIM FOURTEEN (14) OF ACCREDITED
HOME LENDERS AND TO STRIP LIEN EFFECTIVE UPON DISCHARGE**

THIS CASE is before the Court on the Debtors' Motion to Value Claim Fourteen (14) secured by the homestead property mortgage held by ACCREDITED HOME LENDERS and to Strip Lien (the "Motion") filed March 5, 2015 [Doc 32] and said Creditor has failed to file a written response to the Motion in accordance with Rule 2002-4, Local Bankruptcy Rules.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED**:

1. The Motion to Value Claim Fourteen (14) is GRANTED pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §506(a) and the mortgage lien is voided pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §506(d).
2. The value of that portion of Claim Fourteen (14) secured by Real Property (Homestead) located at 4169 Broad Creek Ln, Jacksonville FL is \$0.00. The balance of this claim shall be treated as unsecured.

3. The legal description of this property is as follows:
Lot 108, Cambridge Estates, Unit Four, according to the plat thereof, as recorded in Plat Book 55, pages 73, 73A through 73G, inclusive, of the current Public Records of Duval County, Florida.
4. The mortgage held by ACCREDITED HOME LENDERS recorded on May 6, 2004 at Book 11786, Pages 2111 through 2118, Instrument No. 2004143774 of the official records of Duval County, Florida, shall be deemed void and shall be extinguished automatically, without further Court order, upon entry of the Debtors' discharge in this Chapter 13 case; provided, however, that the Court reserves jurisdiction to consider, if appropriate, the avoidance of ACCREDITED HOME LENDERS's lien prior to the entry of the Debtors' discharge.
5. This order does not prohibit ACCREDITED HOME LENDERS from asserting, at any time prior to the time when the lien is avoided by this order upon entry of the Debtor's discharge, any rights it may have as a defendant in any foreclosure proceeding brought by a senior mortgagee, including the right to claim excess proceeds from any foreclosure sale.
