**JUDGMENT FOR PLAINTIFF FOR ATTORNEY'S FEES AND COSTS**

THIS CAUSE came before this Court pursuant to this Court's March 17, 2005 Order on Motion to Show Cause ("Order"). In said Order, this Court awarded the Plaintiff, FINOVA Capital Corporation ("FINOVA") its reasonable attorneys fees and costs against the Defendants, jointly and severally, for the expense that FINOVA incurred in preparing and prosecuting its Motion to Show Cause and Motion for Summary Judgment (Texas State Court). FINOVA has submitted the affidavits of Suneese Eagleton and Louis Rouleau in support of its award of fees and costs. The Court has considered these affidavits. Accordingly, it is :

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that:

1. The Court finds that FINOVA incurred reasonable attorneys fees and costs in filing and pursuing the Motion to Show Cause in this Court and Motions for Summary Judgment in the Texas State Court in the amount of \$ 5,401.00 and that FINOVA shall recover from the Defendants **D.W. Burns, Inc. d/b/a West Park Drug**, 213 W. Park Avenue, Hareford, Texas 79045, **David Burns, Individually**, 213 W. Park Avenue, Hareford, Texas 79045; **Good News Wholesale, Inc., d/b/a Bi-Wize Health Mart**, 902 Main Street, Friona, Texas 79035, **Mike Hanes, Individually**, 902 Main Street, Friona, Texas 79035; **Garland E. Coleman, Jr. d/b/a Coleman Pharmacy**, 201 N.W. Second, Dimmitt, Texas 79027 and **Garland E. Coleman**, individually, 201 N.W. Second, Dimmitt, Texas 79027, jointly and severally, the sum of \$ 5400.00 for which let execution issue forthwith. The Defendants shall pay FINOVA the above amount within 20 days of the date of this Judgment. This judgment amount shall bear interest at nine percent (9%) per annum until paid in full.
