
FINAL JUDGMENT DETERMINING DEBT TO BE NON-DISCHARGEABLE

This Adversary Proceeding came before the Court upon the Complaint filed by the Plaintiff, First Mutual Sales Finance, Inc, against the Defendant, Barbara E. Baker on December 12, 2008. Based upon the consent of the Debtor at the hearing held on January 15, 2010, it is ORDERED and ADJUDGED:

1. Judgment is entered in favor of Plaintiff, First Mutual Sales Finance, Inc., whose address is 425 Pike Street, Seattle, Washington 98101, and against Defendant, Barbara E. Baker, whose last known address is 17340 S.E. 98th Circle, Summerfield, Florida 34491, in the amount of \$15,741.00 to accrue interest at a rate of .35% per annum from the date of this Judgment, for which let execution issue.

2. The debt owed by Defendant, Barbara E. Baker, to Plaintiff, First Mutual Sales Finance, Inc., under Paragraph 1 of this Judgment is non-dischargeable pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 523(a)(2)(B), from any discharge granted the Defendant in the underlying bankruptcy case or otherwise.
