JUDGMENT

This matter came before the Court on the Debtors' Second Motion for Sanctions Against FIA Card Services as Successor to Bank Card Services/Wachovia Securities and MNBNA (Doc. No. 26) ("Motion") filed by Bruce R. Wasson and Lavinia Ann Wasson, the Debtors herein (collectively, the "Debtors"), against FIA Card Services as Successor to Bank Card Services/Wachovia ("FIA") and MBNA. An evidentiary hearing was held on March 26, 2007 at which the Debtors and their counsel appeared. The Court makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law after reviewing the pleadings and evidence, hearing live argument, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises. After reviewing the pleadings and evidence, receiving testimony and exhibits, and in conformity with and pursuant to the **Order** entered contemporaneously herewith, it is

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that **JUDGMENT** is hereby entered in favor of Bruce R. Wasson and Lavinia Ann Wasson in the total amount of \$6,500.00 against FIA Card Services as Successor to Bank Card Services/Wachovia ("FIA") and MBNA. The amount of \$6,500.00 is comprised of: \$1,000.00 for actual costs, \$4,000.00 for punitive damages and \$1,500.00 awarded for attorney's fees pursuant to the Order entered

contemporaneously; and it is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that

1. FIA Card Services is ordered to cease all collection activity against the Debtors and to correctly update the Debtors credit file within fourteen days of the date of this Order.

2. The Debtors may seek additional relief for any additional attorneys' fees they incur to enforce this order.

3. This Court reserves jurisdiction in this cause to insure compliance with its Order, and with the prior Order on the First Motion for Sanctions.
