**NON-DISCHARGEABLE FINAL JUDGMENT**



ORDERED and ADJUDGED:

1. That a Non-Dischargeable Final Judgment is entered against DALE WILLIAM BRIDGES, whose address is 6548 Pompano Place South, St. Petersburg, Florida 33707-3825 in favor of HOCHBERG HOLDINGS LIMITED PARTNERSHIP, whose address is 317 Ocean Boulevard, Golden Beach, Florida 33160 in the principal sum of \$175,217.17. This Judgment shall be deemed non-dischargeable.
2. This Judgment amount shall bear interest at the legal rate.
3. The Court reserves jurisdiction to enforce this Judgment in accordance with and pursuant to the parties' Settlement Agreement entered into on April 29, 2010, and to tax attorneys' fees and costs in the enforcement of same.
4. The Court further reserves jurisdiction to amend this Judgment at anytime as provided by and in accordance with the terms and conditions of the parties' said Settlement Agreement.
