
**FINAL JUDGMENT ON DEBT DETERMINED TO
BE NON-DISCHARGEABLE AND AWARDING DAMAGES**

In accordance with the Order Determining Debt to be Nondischargeable and Determining Damages (Dkt No 27, 29)

JUDGMENT IS HEREBY ENTERED in favor of Plaintiff, Dianna Williams¹, against Debtor/Defendant WILLIAM MATOS, JR., the sum of \$100,000 which shall bear interest from the date of loss, November 23, 2007, at the statutory rate then in effect, through the date of entry of this Judgment, and thereafter shall bear interest at the federal post-judgement rate of .20%, which debt is non-dischargeable pursuant to 11 U.S.C. 523 (a)(2)(A).

The court awards the Plaintiff in the amount of \$895.00, in accordance with the Bill of Costs filed at Dkt. No. 26.
