**DEFAULT AND FINAL JUDGMENT IN GARNISHMENT**

This case came before the Court on the Motion for Entry of Default Against Garnishee, Keystone Empire, LLC (Doc. 192) of the Plaintiff, M. DAVIS MANAGEMENT, INC. (the "Corporation" or "Plaintiff"). The Court, having reviewed the Motion and the Court file, finds that:

1. The above named Garnishee, KEYSTONE EMPIRE, LLC, failed to answer the Continuing Writ of Garnishment (Doc. 173) served upon Dennis Zink as Registered Agent of Garnishee (Docs. 190-1 and 192-1).


2. The Garnishee has defaulted in this cause and rendered itself liable for the whole amount of the Judgment debt of the Defendant, DENNIS ZINK, pursuant to Florida Statute § 77.081.

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that:

The above named Plaintiff shall have and recover from the above named Garnishee the sum of **\$1,030,241**, for which let execution issue. Pursuant to Florida Statute § 77.0305, as salary or wages are being garnished, the Writ of Garnishment previously served shall continue and the Garnishee is hereby ordered to continue to withhold the appropriate amount from Defendant' s wages or salary (25% of disposable earnings each pay period) and to make the periodic payments thereof directly to the Plaintiff through its attorney, if applicable, until said judgment amount listed on said Writ is satisfied or until further order of the Court.

The Garnishee shall be allowed to collect up to \$5.00 against the salary or wages of the Defendant as reimbursement for administrative costs for the first deduction from the Defendant's salary or wages, and up to \$1.00 for each deduction thereafter.
