THIS CAUSE came on for hearing on November 8, 2011, with proper notice to all parties in interest, at the Pretrial Conference. For the reasons stated orally and recorded in open court, that shall constitute the decision of the Court, it is hereupon,

**ORDERED** as follows:

1. The Writ of Garnishment by Robert Half International, Inc. is avoided as a preferential transfer pursuant to §547 of the United States Bankruptcy Code.
2. Synovus Bank is entitled to attorney fees, pursuant to Fla. Statute 77.28, in the amount of One Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Two Dollars (\$1,332.00).
3. Synovus Bank is entitled to the balance of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) deposit being held in the registry of the County Court, In and For Pinellas County, Florida.
4. Synovus Bank will turn over the Six Thousand Five Hundred Nineteen Dollars and Twenty-Nine Cents (\$6,519.29) it is holding to the Trustee, Stephen L. Meininger, after deducting the attorney fees it is entitled to in the amount of One Thousand

Three Hundred Thirty Two Dollars (\$1,332.00) for a total net amount of Five Thousand One Hundred Eighty Seven Dollars and Twenty-Nine Cents (\$5,187.29).
