
FINAL JUDGMENT

In accordance with the parties Joint Motion for Entry of Judgment Against Celso Fernandez, it is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. Celso Fernandez is indebted to the United States of America for unpaid federal income taxes, plus interest for the 2001 and 2002 tax years in the total amount of \$19,154.97 as of April 16, 2010, plus fees, interest, and all statutory additions thereafter as provided by law.
2. Celso Fernandez is indebted to the United States of America for unpaid federal income taxes, plus interest for the 1998 tax year in the total amount of \$28,894.11 as of April 16, 2010, plus fees, interest, and all statutory additions thereafter as provided by law.
3. Celso Fernandez's unpaid federal income tax liability for 2001 and 2002, plus interest thereon, is excepted from discharge by 11 U.S.C. § 523(a)(1)(A).
4. Celso Fernandez's liability for penalties on the tax liabilities referenced above are not excepted from discharge.


5. This adversary proceeding is dismissed with prejudice.
