ORDERED AND ADJUDGED



3. Any Claims filed by Citibank, Federal Savings Bank arising from this mortgage shall be treated as an unsecured claim in the Chapter 13 Case.

Further, if this bankruptcy proceeding is dismissed, the mortgage will no longer be considered void and shall be restored as a secured debt.
