STIPULATED FINAL JUDGMENT

Based upon the Settlement Stipulation filed on behalf of Plaintiff, Comerica Bank, N.A. ("Comerica") and Defendant, Mark N. Bacon ("Bacon"), it is ORDERED and ADJUDGED:


1. Judgment is entered in favor of Comerica determining that a debt of Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000) shall be non-dischargeable pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §523(a)(6).

2. Comerica is authorized to seek and to obtain (without any opposition from Bacon) a state court judgment in the amount of Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000) against Bacon.

3. Comerica and Bacon shall bear their own attorneys' fees and costs with respect to this adversary proceeding.
