**AGREED ORDER RESOLVING COMPLAINT AND GRANTING

1. Remissions shall be made to Weltman, Weinberg and Reis, P.O. Box 93784, Cleveland, Ohio 44101, with reference number 30262218.


2. Upon payment in full of the sum of \$1,000.00, Plaintiff's claim against Defendant shall be deemed fully paid and satisfied.
3. So long as the Defendant makes the payment specified in paragraph 1 above and payment is received by September 15, 2014, no interest shall be charged on the outstanding balance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Judgment is non-dischargeable and is excepted from a discharge in these proceedings or any subsequent proceedings attempting to discharge Defendant's obligations.

This Judgment resolves the last pending claim and closes this case.
