
ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DIRECTED that:

1. This Court has jurisdiction of the subject matter and Defendant, Prior Chemical Corporation. Due and legal service of process has been had upon said Defendant. The Default against said Defendant be and are hereby ratified and confirmed.

2. The Plaintiff, Anchor Glass Container Corporation, whose address is 3101 West Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard, Suite 301, Tampa, Florida 33607, shall have and recover from Defendant, Prior Chemical Corporation, whose last known address is 460 Park Avenue, New York, New York 10022, Attention: John Dram or any Registered Agent, Officer or a Managing or General Agent, and whose employer identification number is unknown, the sum of \$42,000.00 together with post-judgment interest at 4.91 % per annum from the date hereof until paid, plus any further sums in connection herewith, for all of which sum let execution issue.

3. This Court reserves jurisdiction to enter all further orders, judgments and decrees as may be necessary, including the imposition of reasonable attorneys' fees and costs.
