FINAL JUDGMENT GRANTING DEBTOR'S MOTION FOR SANCTIONS


AND AWARDING REASONABLE ATTORNEY FEE

ORDERED, DECREED, and ADJUDGED that said Motion is GRANTED and further that JUDGMENT is hereby entered, pursuant to 11 USC 105(a), against AMERICAN GENERAL FINANCE and in favor of Attorney for the Debtor, Isabel E. Freeman, Esquire, who is awarded a reasonable attorney's fee in the amount of TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,100.00) plus interest at the applicable Federal judgment rate until paid, with said judgment to be paid as follows: \$2,100.00 to Isabel E. Freeman, Esquire, as and for attorney's fees and it is further

ORDERED, DECREED, and ADJUDGED that for the foregoing sums let execution issue.
