**STIPULATED FINAL JUDGMENT**

Pursuant to the terms of the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement (Docket No. 10), filed in this Adversary Proceeding, the Court finds that the Debtor's obligation to Edgar N. Bedley in the amount \$350,000.00 is nondischargeable under Section 523(a)(2) of the Bankruptcy Code. Accordingly,

**IT IS ADJUDGED**, that Plaintiff, Edgar N. Bedley, whose address is 4815 East River Hills Drive, Tampa, Florida 33617, shall recover judgment against the Defendant Traci Dean Walters (social security number xxx-xx-4280), whose address is 3949 Lakeshore Drive, Palm Harbor, Florida 34684, in the amount of \$350,000.00, for which sum let execution issue. IT IS FURTHER

**ADJUDGED**, that Plaintiff will not seek to garnish any wages earned by Defendant, provided that and for so long as Defendant timely, completely and accurately cooperates in the currently pending action in the Circuit Court in and for Pinellas County, Florida, entitled *Edgar*

*N. Bedley vs. Tracie Dean Walters and Oceans Funding Company, Inc., a Florida corporation, National Union Fire Insurance Company of Pittsburg, Pa., and AIG American International Companies, Case No. 07-001194-CI-021 (the "State Court Action").* However, if Defendant fails to timely, completely and accurately cooperate in the State Court Action, Plaintiff shall thereupon have the right to immediately exercise any and all rights as a judgment creditor, including but not limited to the right of garnishment, to collect on this Stipulated Final Judgment.

IT IS FURTHER

**ADJUDGED**, that the Bankruptcy Court shall retain jurisdiction to give force and effect to the conditions contained in the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement (Docket No.10). IT IS FURTHER

**ADJUDGED**, that the obligations of the Defendant to Plaintiff under this judgment is excepted from discharge under 11 U.S.C. § 523(a)(2).
