ORDER FOR MONEY JUDGEMENT

THIS CASE came on for hearing on February 5, 2009, upon the Motion for Order to Show Cause why Debtor should not be held in contempt for failure to Obey Order of the Court and Request to Revoke Discharge filed by the Trustee, Angela Esposito. The Court, having considered the motion together with the record, finds that a Judgment should be granted. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that the Motion is granted, a judgment is entered in the trustee's favor. The court reserves ruling on the revocation of discharge. If the Trustee brings forth proof that warrants sanctions, the court will consider sanctions including revocation of the discharge. Trustee is granted a money judgment in the amount of Six thousand nine hundred seventy-three dollars and thirty-five cents (\$6,973.35).
