This matter came before the court on May 20, 2010, for a pretrial hearing, at which time the court took up a Joint Motion for Approval of Stipulation Regarding Non-Dischargeability of Debt Owed to The Social Security Administration (Dkt. No. 4). After giving the matter due consideration, the stipulation is adopted and it is


ORDERED:

1. A civil monetary penalty that was assessed by the Social Security Administration against Debtor is non-dischargeable under the provisions of 11 U.S.C. § 523(a)(2)(4).

2. These debts originally totaled \$6,869.00. Social Security Administration records show that Plaintiff has remitted \$450.00 toward payment of the debts. The current outstanding balance of the debt is \$6,419.00.


