DEFAULT FINAL JUDGMENT AGAINST DEFENDANT REBECCA J. CALIX

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on the motion of the Plaintiff, Soneet R. Kapila, Chapter 7 Trustee (the "Trustee") for the bankruptcy estates of Louis J. Pearlman and each other jointly administered debtor, for Entry of Default Final Judgment against Defendant Rebecca J. Calix (the "Motion"). The Court, having considered the Motion, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, does hereby

ORDER as follows:

1. The Motion is granted.
2. The Trustee shall have and recover, and Judgment shall be and is hereby entered in favor of the Trustee against Defendant Rebecca J. Calix in the amount of \$19,000.00, for which

sums execution shall issue forthwith.

5. In accordance with Fed. R. Civ. P. 54(b), the Court certifies that there is no just


