**ORDER GRANTING DEBTORS' MOTION TO DETERMINE
SECURED STATUS OF RIVERSIDE NATIONAL BANK
AND TO STRIP LIEN EFFECTIVE UPON DISCHARGE**

THIS CASE came on for consideration on the Debtor's Motion to Determine Secured Status of Riverside National Bank and to Strip Lien (the "Motion") pursuant to Middle District of Florida Local Rule 2002-4. The Court, considering the Motion and the absence of any record objection to the relief requested in the Motion by any party in interest, deems the Motion to be uncontested.

The real property (the "Real Property") that is the subject of the Motion is located at 5420 Atlantic View, St. Augustine, FL 32080, and more particularly described as follows:

LOT 4, BLOCK P, ANASTASIA HILLS, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF, RECORDED IN MAP BOOK 3 PAGE(S) 25 OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. If Riverside National Bank timely files a proof of claim based upon this second mortgage, its claim shall be treated as an unsecured claim in the Chapter 7 Case.
3. The mortgage on the real property held by Riverside National Bank, recorded on February 9, 2006, at Book 2640, Page 796, Instrument No. 2006010235, of the official records of St. Johns County, Florida, shall be deemed void and shall be extinguished automatically, without further court order, upon entry of the Debtor's discharge in this

Chapter 7 case. Further, if this Chapter 7 case is dismissed, the mortgage will no longer be considered void and shall be restored as a secured debt.
