HOFFER, as Trustee for The Milliron Family Trust UTD, and against Defendant, DANIEL JOSEPH DURAN (XXX-XX-3949), 1702 Blind Pond Avenue, Lutz, Florida 33549, and the Plaintiff shall recover from the Defendant the sum of \$217,116.48 together with interest at the rate of 5.0 % per annum, for which let execution issue.


