AND FOR MONEY DUE AND OWING



TARDIF JR., Trustee, from the Defendants, John and Diane Matz, the sum of \$7,152.43, in addition to costs in the amount of \$250.00, and attorney's fees in the amount of \$400.00 for a total judgment amount of \$7,802.43. The total judgment amount shall accrue interest pursuant to law, for all of which let execution issue.
