**SUPPLEMENTAL JUDGMENT**

This matter came before the Court on the Motion for Reconsideration (DE 40) filed by Wells Fargo seeking reconsideration of the Memorandum Opinion (DE 35) and contemporaneously entered Judgment (DE 36) holding Kendrick's indebtedness to Wells Fargo dischargeable pursuant to 11 U.S.C. **ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED** that the Judgment shall be paid to Debtor James Bruce Kendrick Sr., c/o David R. McFarlin, counsel for the Debtor, whose address is Wolff, Hill, McFarlin & Herron, P.A., 1851 Colonial Drive, Orlando, Florida, 32804; and it is further

**ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED** that for the foregoing sums let execution issue.
