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**FINAL JUDGMENT**

This adversary proceeding came on for trial on March 17, 2015, on the Complaint filed by the Plaintiff, the United States Trustee, seeking imposition of a fine and an injunction against the Defendants, Christopher Coburn and Coburn Ventures, LLC, for failure to comply with the regulations governing bankruptcy petition preparers provided in 11 U.S.C. § 110. Consistent with the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law entered contemporaneously, it is

**ORDERED:**

1. Judgment is entered in favor of the Plaintiff, the United States Trustee, and against the Defendants, Christopher C. Coburn and Coburn Ventures, LLC.

2. Defendants shall be jointly and severably liable to pay the Plaintiff, the United States Trustee, \$1,000 as a fine under 11 U.S.C. § 110(l), within 60 days of the entry of this Final Judgment.

3. Defendants shall be jointly and severably liable to pay the Debtor, Jose Emmanuel Rivera, \$500 as disgorged fees under 11 U.S.C. § 110(h)(3)(B).

4. Defendants are enjoined from preparing or filing any documents on behalf of other persons in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Florida without complying with the requirements of 11 U.S.C. § 110.
