JUDGMENT

This matter came before the Court on the Complaint (Doc. No. 1) filed by the Plaintiff Kenneth C. Robinson against the Debtor/Defendant Julie Ginter. Defendant did not answer the Complaint.

A hearing was held on April 13, 2011 at which the Plaintiff and Defendant's counsel appeared. The parties announced their intention to settle this matter. The Court ordered Plaintiff to file a statement of what he is owed by Defendant within fourteen (14) days of the hearing. The Court advised the parties if no settlement of this adversary was reached within sixteen (16) days after Plaintiff's statement was filed, the Court would enter a nondischargeable judgment for Plaintiff.

Plaintiff filed a Statement of Monies Owed (Doc. No. 9) on April 27, 2011, in compliance with the Court's order. The parties have not filed a notice of settlement with the Court.

After reviewing the pleadings, hearing the parties' presentations, and in conformity with and pursuant to the **Memorandum Opinion and Order** entered contemporaneously herewith, it is

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that **JUDGMENT** is hereby entered in favor of the Plaintiff Kenneth C. Robinson and against the Debtor/Defendant Julie Ginter and the indebtedness owed to Plaintiff Kenneth C. Robinson by the Debtor/Defendant Julie Ginter pursuant to the Order on Attorney's Fees and the assignment from Snider to Robinson is **NONDISCHARGEABLE** pursuant to 11 U.S.C. Section 523(a)(5) and (15).
