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ORDER

A hearing on various matters was held on February 2, 2010 at which Bruce Grant Bonaventure, the *pro se* Debtor herein (“Debtor”), the Chapter 13 Trustee Laurie K. Weatherford, and counsel for Aurora Loan Services, LLC appeared. The Debtor informed the Court he filed a Motion to Convert the case to Chapter 11 (Doc. No. 54) and requested the Chapter 13 filing fees he paid be applied to the Chapter 11 filing fee.

The Debtor’s request to pay the \$274.00 Chapter 13 filing fee was granted pursuant to the Order Approving Application to Pay Filing Fee in Installments entered on December 9, 2009 (Doc. No. 8) and the payment schedule was modified pursuant to the Order entered on December 20, 2009 (Doc. No. 26). The Debtor has timely paid \$184.00 pursuant to the December 20, 2009 Order. The amount of \$184.00 shall be credited to the Chapter 11 filing fee of \$1,039.00, leaving a balance of \$855.00 due and owing for the Chapter 11 filing fee. 28 U.S.C. § 1930(a) (*hanging paragraph*).

The balance may be paid in installments, but such installment payments may not exceed four and the final installment shall be payable not later than 120 days after the petition date of December 7, 2009 and may be extended to 180 days for cause shown.

FED. R. BANKR. P. 1006(b)(2).

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Debtor's Motion to Convert (Doc. No. 54) is hereby **GRANTED**; and it is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Debtor is hereby directed to pay to filing fee balance of \$855.00 the Court as follows: \$200.00 on or before March 7, 2010; \$200.00 on or before April 7, 2010; \$455.00 on or before May 4, 2010.
