JUDGMENT

This matter came before the Court on the Complaint Objecting to Discharge of Debtor (Adversary Proceeding Doc. ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the general discharge of the Defendant/Debtor Steve Chester McLain is hereby **DENIED** pursuant to 11 U.S.C. Section 727.
