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**ORDER**

This matter came before the Court on the Amended Notice/Motion/Request for Waiver of Filing Fee for Appeal (Doc. No. 148) and the Amended Notice/Motion/Request for Waiver of Filing Fee for Appeal (Doc. No. 153 (collectively, “Amended Requests”) filed by the *pro se* Debtor Bruce Grant Bonaventure (“Debtor”) requesting waiver of the appeal filing fee of \$255.00 relating to his Notice of Appeal (Doc. No. 130).

The Court entered an Order on May 19, 2010 (Doc. No. 138) directing the Debtor to file a motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* in conformity with 28 U.S.C. Section 1915. The Amended Requests contain no financial affidavit establishing the Debtor’s alleged indigent status. The Amended Requests do not comply with 28 U.S.C. Section 1915 and are due to be denied.

Accordingly, it is

**ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED** that the Debtor’s Amended Requests (Doc. Nos. 148, 153) are hereby **DENIED**.
