ORDER

This matter came before the Court on the First Amended Objection to Debtor's Bankruptcy Based on False Pretenses, False Representations, and Actual Fraud (Doc. No. 45) ("Objection") and the letter dated March 8, 2009 with attachments (Doc. No. 46) ("Letter") filed by Jack Durie, Jr., the Plaintiff herein ("Plaintiff").

The Plaintiff's Objection consists of ten pages of single-spaced type with hand-written commentary inserted. The Plaintiff's Letter consists of two pages of single-spaced type with twenty-eight pages of attachments, which include an article entitled "Disqualification of Judges," a transcript of the February 19, 2009 hearing in this Adversary Proceeding, information regarding the Defendant, and information regarding the Plaintiff's legal background. The attachments contain numerous insertions of hand-written commentary.

An Order was entered on February 26, 2009 (Doc. No. 40) enjoining the parties from filing any pleadings or documents unless specifically directed by Court Order or leave of Court has been granted. An Order was entered

on March 10, 2009 (Doc. No. 43) enjoining the Plaintiff from conducting any further discovery and advising the parties the injunction of the February 26, 2009 Order remains in full force and effect.

The Plaintiff's filing of the Objection was not specifically directed by an Order of this Court nor was leave of Court granted for such filing. The Plaintiff's filing of the Letter was not specifically directed by an Order of this Court nor was leave of Court granted for such filing. The Plaintiff filed the Objection and Letter in violation of the February 26, 2009 and March 10, 2009 Orders. The filings are due to be stricken.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Plaintiff's Objection (Doc. No. 45) and Letter (Doc. No. 46) are hereby **STRICKEN**; and it is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the injunctions of the February 26, 2009 and March 10, 2009 Orders remain in full force and effect.
