ORDER EXTENDING TIME
FOR ALL APPELLANTS TO FILE AND
SERVE DESIGNATIONS OF THE RECORD
AND STATEMENTS OF THE ISSUES ON APPEAL

This adversary proceeding came on for hearing of related matters on December 12, 2000. At that time, the court discussed with counsel procedures in connection with prosecuting appeals from the court's judgment entered on November 9, 2000 (Document No. 119). In this regard, the court noted that it has already entered an order extending the time for all parties to appeal (Document No. 120), that some

parties have already filed their notices of appeal (Documents Nos. 143, 145, and 146), and that other parties are expected to do so within the time the parties may do so under the extension that the court has granted. Counsel for the individual defendants also orally moved for an extension of time to comply with the requirements of F.R.B.P. 8006.

For the reasons stated by the court and recorded in open court at the hearing and because of the complexities involved in this proceeding, the court grants the defendants' oral motion. Accordingly, the court hereby extends until March 1, 2001, the time all appellants have to file and serve their designations of the items to be included in the record on appeal and their statements of the issues to be presented on appeal, all as required by F.R.B.P. 8006.

This extension applies to all those parties who have already filed notices of appeal as well as to those parties who may file their notices of appeal in the future.
