PRELIMINARY ORDER ON PLAINTIFF'S BILL OF COSTS

On December 5, 2000, the plaintiff timely filed its bill of costs (Document No. 144A) pursuant to the allowance of costs included in the court's judgment (Document No. 119). At a hearing held on December 12, 2000, the court discussed the bill with counsel for the parties. Based upon that discussion, the court orders as follows:

1. No later than ten days from the date of service of notice of the entry of this order, the plaintiff shall file

and serve additional documentation justifying the allowance of the costs claimed in the bill.

2. No later than ten days thereafter, the defendants may file and serve responses in opposition to the taxation of the requested costs.

3. Upon the expiration of this schedule and based upon the record so made, the court will tax costs.
