Upon consideration of the undersigned, the Local Bankruptcy Rules heretofore promulgated for the Bankruptcy Court of the Middle District of Florida, dated March 30, 1973, are deemed superceded and revoked and the Rules appended hereto with forms are hereby adopted and promulgated to become effective 12:01 a.m., October 1, 1979, and shall govern all practice and procedure in the Bankruptcy Courts after the effective date. It is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Bankruptcy Judges, as deemed to be necessary and proper, are hereby authorized to promulgate additional rules of practice and procedure governing cases filed after October 1, 1979. It is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that these Rules shall remain in full force and effect until Rules of Practice and Procedure are adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States and by Congress and promulgated by the Supreme Court pursuant to its rule making power, 28 U.S.C., ¶2075.
