Due to the impact of Hurricane Ian, the Jacksonville Division of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Florida was closed from 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 28, 2022, through Friday, September 30, 2022, making the Clerk's Office of the Jacksonville Division inaccessible on those dates.

Rule 9006(a)(3)(A), Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, provides in part:

**Rule 9006. Computing and Extending Time**

**(a)(3) Inaccessibility of Clerk's Office.** Unless the court orders otherwise, if the clerk's office is inaccessible:


(A) on the last day for filing under Rule 9006(a)(1), then the time for filing is extended to the same time on the first accessible day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday; . . . (emphasis supplied.)

Accordingly, it is

**ORDERED** that because the Jacksonville Division of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Florida was closed from 2:00 p.m. on September 28, 2022, through September 30, 2022, and the resulting inaccessibility of the Clerk's Office on those

dates, in accordance with Rule 9006(a)(3), the time for filing papers in cases pending in the Jacksonville Division is extended through Monday, October 3, 2022.
