ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
VACATING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER FLMB-2020-1


On February 10, 2020, the Court entered Administrative Order FLMB-2020-1 to adopt interim rules of bankruptcy procedure (“Interim Rules”) approved by the Judicial Conference of the United States to facilitate the uniform implementation of the Small Business Reorganization Act of 2019 on its February 19, 2019 effective date. The Administrative Order provides that the Interim Rules shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.

Subsequently, on December 1, 2022, amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure—that incorporate the provisions of the Interim Rules—became effective. Inasmuch as the Interim Rules have been superseded by the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the Interim Rules are no longer in effect.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that Administrative Order FLMB-2020-1 is **VACATED** effective December 1, 2022.
