ORDER REGARDING TIME PERIODS ENDING ON OCTOBER 6 AND 7, 2016

On October 6 and 7, 2016, because of Hurricane Matthew, the Bryan Simpson United States Courthouse in Jacksonville, Florida, was closed, making the offices of the Clerk of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Jacksonville Division of the Middle District of Florida inaccessible on those days. Rule 9006(a)(3)(A), Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, provides in part:

Rule 9006. Computing and Extending Time

(a)(3) *Inaccessibility of the Clerk's Office*. Unless the court orders otherwise, if the clerk's office is inaccessible:

(A) on the last day for filing under Rule 9006(a)(1), then the time for filing is extended to the first accessible day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday;...(Emphasis supplied.)

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that because of the closing of the Bryan Simpson United States Courthouse in Jacksonville, Florida, on October 6 and 7, 2016, and the resulting inaccessibility of the Clerk's Office on those dates, time periods for all cases in the Jacksonville Division of the

United States Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Florida are extended in accordance with Rule 9006(a)(3), Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure.
