**ORDER REGARDING TIME  
PERIODS ENDING ON OCTOBER 7, 2016**

On October 7, 2016, because of Hurricane Matthew, the Sam M. Gibbons United States Courthouse in Tampa, Florida, was closed, making the offices of the Clerk of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Tampa Division of the Middle District of Florida inaccessible on that day. Rule 9006(a)(3)(A), Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, provides in part:

**Rule 9006. Computing and Extending Time**

(a)(3) *Inaccessibility of the Clerk's Office.* Unless the court orders otherwise, if the clerk's office is inaccessible:

(A) on the last day for filing under Rule 9006(a)(1), then the time for filing is extended to the first accessible day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday;...(Emphasis supplied.)

Accordingly, it is

**ORDERED** that because of the closing of the Sam M. Gibbons United States Courthouse in Tampa, Florida, on October 7, 2016, and the resulting inaccessibility of the Clerk's Office on that date, time periods for all cases in the Tampa Division of the United States

Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Florida are extended in accordance with Rule 9006(a)(3), Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure.
