JUDGMENT

This adversary proceeding came before the Court upon a complaint seeking (i) to deny Defendant's discharge pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 727, or in the alternative seeking an exception to Defendant's discharge pursuant to (ii) § 523(a)(5) or (iii) § 523(a)(15). Upon Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law separately entered, it is

ADJUDGED:

1. Judgment as to Count I is entered in favor of Plaintiff, Kenneth A. Swanson, and against Defendant, Nancy S. Tretick. Defendant's discharge is denied pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 727(a)(4)(A).
2. Count II is dismissed as moot.
3. Count III of the Complaint is dismissed.
